



## Important to know

- You are enrolled in virtual study programs "degree outside Germany"
  - ► Effect: you have no curriculum!
    - Positive:
      - No limitation to certain curriculum.
      - You can choose any course, you can register any exam
        - You do a "free registration", i.e. outside of any curriculum
    - Negative:
      - You sometimes cannot register courses because registration is limited to certain curricula (which forbids free registrations)
      - In case you cannot register a course, contact me!



- ► Choose "courses" to search for a list of courses, maybe filtered by curriculum
  - Informatik [2022], Bachelor (1-subject)
  - Informatik [2023], Master (1-subject)
    - including courses from minors
  - Software Systems Engineering [2025], Master (1-subject)
    - no minor courses, you can focus on computer science

#### • But:

- Only electives, no compulsory courses
  - Most compulsory courses anyway are in German
- Only courses of our faculty






#### Course choice: where to choose from

- At least 50% of courses should be selected from our faculty
  - ▶ BSc. + MSc. Informatik (Computer Science), MSc. Software Systems Engineering, MSc. Data Science, MSc. Human-Centered Intelligent Systems
    - Warning: MSc. Human-Centered Intelligent Systems is joined programme together with University of Bonn. Do not choose courses from University of Bonn!
      - All our courses are also included in the other programmes, so please ignore MSc. Human-Centered Intelligent Systems
    - MSc. Data Science includes lot of courses from Mathematics, BSc./MSc. Informatik has lot of courses from minors
      - Codes of courses from our faculty always start with 12.xxxxx
- The other 50% can be chosen by interest
  - ... given that the teachers agree to your participation

Most courses: lecture + exercise (LE)




Lecture + exercise, 4 hours per week (3L + 1E)





- Most courses: lecture + exercise (LE)
  - You have to take both to get the credits







- Most courses: lecture + exercise (LE)
  - You have to take both to get the credits
  - Sometimes, L + E are having a single RWTHonline entry
  - Sometimes, L and E have separate entries
    - But only for time/room planning, has no meaning for you



## Other course types:

- ► IS/SE: seminar
  - You have to do a literature survey on a given topic, write a paper, give a presentation
- ► LA: lab/pratical
  - Software development project
- ► TU: tutorial (exercise)
  - Small exercise groups, typically only for compulsory courses on bachleor level





## Where do courses take place?


- Most computer science courses take place in Computer Science Center
- Others in ITC, C.A.R.L., Audimax, ...

## **Course registration**

## Registration for lectures/exercises mandatory

- ► You get access to an associated Moodle room
  - All course material, exercises, announcements, e-mail lists only available in the Moodle room

#### • Note:

- Not all teachers have activated registration yet
- Usually, registration is open for months, but for some courses the registration closes one or two weeks after start of lectuers
  - Especially if course is limited and places have to be assigned
- Registration for courses of other departments/faculties may have additional rules
- ▶ If no registration is possible for some course, contact me





## **Course registration**

#### Seminars/labs:

- No registration on your own possible
- Places in seminars/labs are centrally distributed in our department
  - June/July for winter semester
  - January for summer semester
- ► If you stay for two semesters, you can apply for a place during these times via <a href="https://supra.informatik.rwth-aachen.de">https://supra.informatik.rwth-aachen.de</a>
- ► If you are interested in a seminar/lab now, contact the teachers to ask if places are available

#### **Courses and examinations**

- Registering for courses as before is only for getting access to learning material and information
  - You can register for as many courses as you like to have a look a them
  - When being sure about the courses you want to really take, register exams for them
    - Only courses with exam registrations end up in your transcript of records!





#### **Courses and examinations**

- Note: teachers decide on criteria for exam admission
  - ► Attend the first lecture (or study the slides) to find out about them
    - For some courses you can just attend the exam
    - For some courses you have to get 50% of points in e-tests during the semester
    - For some courses you have to get 50% of points in homework during the semester
    - For some courses you have to pass a midterm exam
    - ... or variants/combinations
  - ► Carefully listen to the information given in the first lecture!





## **Exam registration**

- Has to be done via "exams" in RWTHonline
  - Registration opens in general on 15 November, maybe earlier for some courses
  - Registrations for exams in 1st period (~February) closes on 15 January
    - Keep the deadline! Later registration not possible!
  - Registration for exams in 2nd period (~March) closes individually one week before the corresponding exam date
  - Deregistration is possible till 3 workdays before an exam


- You can download own certificate of results from RWTHonline



- First variant: all exam results
- "Only positive" variant: only passed exams listed





## **Transcript of Records**

## Procedure to get the Transcript of Records:

- You can download your transcript via RWTHonline (see before)
- ▶ If a signature is needed, send it to me by e-mail
  - You will get it back digitally signed
  - Tell me if some other person should receive the transcript, i.e. the International Office of your home university
- Transcript only includes results of exams registered in RWTHonline
  - No results of language courses! *To include language courses*:
    - You get a certificate of your language course's results from Language Center
    - Send the certificate to the Central Examination Office (contact see <u>https://www.rwth-aachen.de/go/id/biofqz/lidx/1</u>) – they put it into your records
      - Send the certificates there as soon as possible





## **Transcript of Records**

#### A short note

- Credits for courses shown on your grades certificate may differ from your learning agreement
  - Side effect of a new procedure contact me if this causes trouble, I can set up the transcript manually with correct numbers
- ► No course codes are printed on the transcript
  - Contact me if this causes trouble, I can set up the transcript manually including codes
- ► Titles of exams are printed on the transcript
  - Which might differ from the module titels
    - Contact me if this causes trouble, I can set up the transcript manually with correct titles
